- Tobacco Commission: Will submit a proposal to the Tobacco Commission to fund the improvement and management of our allied health programs. Included will be a Dean of all the college nursing and nurse aid programs and the expansion of the RN program in South Boston.

- Meals On Wheels: There will be a banquet on the Daniel Campus February 14.
- W.I.A: Al Roberts and Linda Sheffield met with a group of WIA managers. We will offer a computer literacy class, preparation for employment, and others to their clients.
- Rapid Response: The College may be able to secure Rapid Response money to provide short-term training.
- D.O.L. Grants: The Department of Labor will likely receive Economic Stimulus money for energy-oriented projects, so we will look at programs we might ask them to fund.
- R.U.S. Grant: The College intends to apply to RUS to fund distance education for our nursing program, particularly the expansion of its simulation labs.
- Title III: The College has received unofficial notification regarding Title III funding for Bridges to Success, which will expand the Bridges program to the Daniel campus and fully fund the program at Christanna. It calls for setting up comprehensive Learning Centers on both campuses, employing staff, purchasing software, and so on.
